Spelling list: ti and ci saying /sh/

In the middle of longer words, like *station* and *musician*, the /sh/ sound is often spelled *ti* or *ci*. This spelling variation frequently appears in words derived from Latin.

Take some time to work through these examples, as recognising this pattern will make it easier to spell other words that contain these sounds. We'll revisit *ci* and *ti* words in Units 28 and 30.

station He works in a train **station**.

action I would like to suggest a plan of **action** .

nation We must learn from our history to become a better **nation** .

mention Did I **mention** that it's my birthday next week?

section Have you read each **section** of the test carefully?

direction He was worried he was going in the wrong **direction**.

information I could not withhold the **information** any longer.

musician The **musician** had to audition to join the band.

special We hold a **special** service at Christmas time.

delicious The table was full of **delicious** food.

initial My **initial** reaction was amazement.
