## Spelling list: General guidelines for adding other suffixes - part 2

If a base word ends in y preceded by a consonant, change the y to i before all suffixes except those beginning with i. Keep the y if the suffix begins with i as ii is not permissible in English except in taxiing and skiing. Letters and Sounds, Phase Six.

happy We were **happy** to dance and sing.

happiness The party was full of **happiness**.

happier Affluence does not necessarily lead to a **happier** life.

baby If the **baby** is asleep there is peace and quiet.

babies This hospital ward is for mothers with new **babies** .

babyish That is **babyish** behaviour.

carry Can you manage to **carry** that all by yourself?

carried The knight **carried** a shield.

carrying A satchel is useful for **carrying** books at school.

taxiing Our plane was **taxiing** before take-off.

skiing He loves **skiing** in the French Alps.
