

## Spelling list: General guidelines for adding other suffixes - part 1

If a base word ends in an e which is part of a split digraph, drop the e if the suffix begins with a vowel. Keep the e if the suffix begins with a consonant. Letters and Sounds, Phase Six.

hope	Let's <b>hope</b> for some good weather.
hoping	I'm <b>hoping</b> my job will be made permanent.
hopeful	I was <b>hopeful</b> about the result.
like	I don't <b>like</b> the way you said that.
liked	Joe <b>liked</b> to slide on the ice.
safe	My shed will be <b>safe</b> with this padlock on the door.
safely	Cross the road <b>safely</b> when the traffic stops.
