artery	An artery is a blood vessel that carries blood from the heart to the body.
backbone	The backbone is the series of vertebrae forming the axis of the skeleton and protecting the spinal cord.
bone	Bone is rigid connective tissue that makes up the skeleton of vertebrates.
muscle	Muscle is tissue consisting predominantly of contractile cells.
nerve	A nerve is a fiber that transmits impulses of sensation from the brain to the rest of the body.
pelvis	The pelvis is the structure of the vertebrate skeleton supporting the lower limbs in humans.
rib	A rib is one of twelve pairs of curved arches of bone extending from the spine to or toward the sternum.
skeleton	A skeleton is the hard structure (bones and cartilages) that provides a frame for the body of an animal.
skull	The skull is the bony skeleton of the head of vertebrates.
spine	The spine is the series of vertebrae forming the axis of the skeleton and protecting the spinal cord.
vein	A vein is a blood vessel that carries blood from the capillaries toward the heart.
