

Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (construct - convert)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

construct	If you construct something, it means you build it.
construction	Construction is the work related to building something.
consult	If you consult someone, it means you seek information or advice from them.
consultation	A consultation is a conference between two or more people to consider a particular question.
consume	If you consume something, it means you eat or use it.
consumer	A consumer is a person who uses goods or services.
contact	If you contact someone, it means you establish communication with them.
contemporary	If something is contemporary , it means it is characteristic of the present.
context	The word context is used to describe the circumstances that surround a situation or event.
contract	A contract is a binding agreement between two or more people that is enforceable by law.
contradiction	A contradiction is when two opposing ideas appear together.
contrary	Contrary means opposite in nature.
contrast	Contrast is when two things are compared to show their opposition or dissimilarity.
contribution	A contribution is the part played by a person in bringing about a result.
controversy	A controversy is a dispute where there is strong disagreement.
convene	If you convene somewhere, it means you meet there.

convention	A convention is the way something is usually done or has traditionally been done.
conversely	Conversely is used to introduce an idea that is the reverse of the one before.
convert	If you convert something, you change it from one thing to another.
