

## Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (negate - numerous)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

negate	If you <b>negate</b> something, it means you make it ineffective.
negative	If something is <b>negative</b> , it means it is characterised by denial, opposition, or resistance.
network	A <b>network</b> is an interconnected system of things or people.
neutral	If someone is <b>neutral</b> , it means they do not favour either side of a dispute.
nevertheless	<b>Nevertheless</b> means 'despite anything to the contrary'.
nonchalant	If someone is <b>nonchalant</b> , it means they are unconcerned.
nonetheless	<b>Nonetheless</b> means 'despite anything to the contrary'.
normal	If something is <b>normal</b> , it means it confirms to a collective standard.
norms	The <b>norms</b> are the things that are typical for a particular time, group, or situation.
notion	A <b>notion</b> is a vague idea in which some confidence is placed.
notwithstanding	<b>Notwithstanding</b> means 'despite anything to the contrary'.
nuclear	If something is <b>nuclear</b> , it means it relates to the nucleus of an atom.
numerous	<b>Numerous</b> is another word for many.
