If something is **financial**, it means it is related to the commercial activity of financial

providing funds and capital.

finite If something is **finite**, it means there is only a certain amount of it.

flexibility Flexibility is how easily something can be bent or shaped.

fluctuations Fluctuations are instances of change to a number or amount.
