

## Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (via - withdraw)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

via	If you go <b>via</b> somewhere, it means you travel through it on your way to your final destination.
violation	A <b>violation</b> is an act that disregards an agreement or a right.
virtually	<b>Virtually</b> means in essence or effect but not in fact.
visible	If something is <b>visible</b> , it means you can see it.
vision	<b>Vision</b> is the ability to see.
visual	<b>Visual</b> means related to sight.
vivid	If something is <b>vivid</b> , it means it is striking and powerful.
volume	<b>Volume</b> is the amount of 3D space occupied by an object.
voluntary	If something is <b>voluntary</b> , it means you have a choice about whether or not you do it.
welfare	<b>Welfare</b> is a state of being happy, healthy, and prosperous.
whereas	The word <b>whereas</b> is used to introduce a contrasting idea.
whereby	<b>Whereby</b> is used to describe the way by which someone does something.
widespread	<b>Widespread</b> means present over a large area.
withdraw	If you <b>withdraw</b> from something, it means you step back from it.
