beginner	A <b>beginner</b> is someone who is new to a particular field or activity.
bonus	A <b>bonus</b> is an additional payment (or other remuneration) to employees as a means of increasing output.
brand	A <b>brand</b> is the name given to a product or service.
business	<b>Business</b> is the activity of providing goods and services involving financial and commercial and industrial aspects.
commerce	<b>Commerce</b> is the activity of sales and purchases of goods and services.
economy	<b>Economy</b> refers to the system of production and distribution and consumption.
equipment	<b>Equipment</b> refers to the instruments needed for an undertaking or to perform a service.
experience	<b>Experience</b> is the accumulation of knowledge or skill that results from direct participation in events or activities.
factory	A <b>factory</b> is a plant consisting of one or more buildings with facilities for manufacturing.
fund	A <b>fund</b> is a financial institution that sells shares to individuals and invests in securities issued by other companies.
goods	<b>Goods</b> are articles of commerce.
industry	<b>Industry</b> is the organized action of making of goods and services for sale.
private	If a company or industry is <b>private</b> , it is owned by individuals rather than the state.
product	A <b>product</b> is a commodity offered for sale.

property	<b>Property</b> refers to the ownership of buildings and the land associated with them.
public	If a company or industry is <b>public</b> , it is owned by the state.
salary	<b>Salary</b> is the money paid to someone for doing a job.
trademark	A <b>trademark</b> is a formally registered symbol identifying the manufacturer or distributor of a product.
