abuse	To <b>abuse</b> someone is to treat them in a cruel or inhumane way.
bribe	To <b>bribe</b> someone is to make illegal payments to them in exchange for favors or influence.
burgle	To <b>burgle</b> is to enter and rob a dwelling.
forge	To <b>forge</b> something is to make a copy of it with the intent to deceive someone.
kidnap	To <b>kidnap</b> someone is to take them away to an undisclosed location against their will.
mug	To <b>mug</b> someone is to rob them using the threat of violence.
rebel	To <b>rebel</b> is to break established rules or customs.
rob	To <b>rob</b> is to take something away by force or without the consent of the owner.
slander	To <b>slander</b> someone is to attach their reputation.
smuggle	To <b>smuggle</b> is to import or export without paying customs duties.
steal	To <b>steal</b> is to take something without the owner's consent.
trespass	To <b>trespass</b> is to enter another's property without right or permission.
