Spelling list: Short /e/ spelled ea : set 1

The short /e/ sound is often spelled with *ea*, as in *head* or *bread*. Although *ea* includes two letters, it makes the same sound as the *e* in words like *bed*. From your list, examples like *meanth*, *spread*, and *breath* all follow this pattern. Keep an eye out for *ea* words - soon you'll recognise them easily in both reading and spelling.
