## Spelling list: Short /e/spelled ea: set 2

The short /e/ sound can be spelled with the letters *ea*, as seen in the words *ready* and *steady*. Even though there are two letters, they combine to make one an *e* sound like in the word *red*. In this list, words like *feather*, *weather*, and *measure* follow this rule. Spotting this pattern will help you with both reading and spelling.
