

## Spelling list: Emotion, negative

afraid	Someone who is <b>afraid</b> is filled with fear or apprehension.
angry	Someone who is <b>angry</b> feels strong annoyance or displeasure.
annoyed	Someone who is <b>annoyed</b> feels slight anger or impatience.
confused	Someone who is <b>confused</b> is unable to think with clarity.
disappointed	Someone who is <b>disappointed</b> feels displeasure at a failure to fulfil an expectation.
furious	Someone who is <b>furious</b> feels very angry, perhaps violently so.
grouchy	Someone who is <b>grouchy</b> feels annoyed or irritable.
jealous	Someone who is <b>jealous</b> feels painfully desirous of another's advantages.
possessive	Someone who is <b>possessive</b> is controlling or dominating.
regretful	Someone who is <b>regretful</b> feels sorrow or a sense of loss over something.
sad	Someone who is <b>sad</b> feels sorrow or unhappiness.
scared	Someone who is <b>scared</b> feels fear and apprehension.
sorrowful	Someone who is <b>sorrowful</b> experiences great unhappiness.
speechless	Someone who is <b>speechless</b> is temporarily incapable of speaking, perhaps due to shock or excitement.
embarrassed	Someone who is <b>embarrassed</b> feels uncomfortable due to shame or wounded pride.
