

## Spelling list: *i-e* words - set 1

One way of spelling the long /i/ sound is by adding the letter *e* to the end of the word. You can practise spelling the long *i* sound by working through this list of *i-e* words.

hide	We can play <b>hide</b> and seek.
wide	The new road will have four <b>wide</b> lanes.
bride	The <b>bride</b> wore a long white veil.
pile	He put the clean washing in a <b>pile</b> .
crime	The detective must prove who committed the <b>crime</b> .
time	There's no <b>time</b> to waste.
fine	The table was laid with <b>fine</b> silverware.
shine	He polished the silverware to make it <b>shine</b> .
spine	She suffered an injury to her <b>spine</b> .
ripe	Are the apples <b>ripe</b> yet?
stripe	A red <b>stripe</b> was painted down the middle of the wall.
rise	I like to <b>rise</b> at six every morning.
wise	The doctor gave me some very <b>wise</b> counsel.
quite	It's <b>quite</b> a long way to walk.
dive	Are you going to <b>dive</b> into the pool?
fire	The flames of the <b>fire</b> kept us warm.
wire	The <b>wire</b> on the plug is loose.
kite	I love to fly my <b>kite</b> .
file	Please attach this <b>file</b> to the email.
