briefcase	A <b>briefcase</b> is a case with a handle that's used for carrying papers or files or books.
coat	A <b>coat</b> is an outer garment that has sleeves and covers the body from shoulder down.
hanger	A hanger is used to hang up clothing in a cupboard.
hook	A <b>hook</b> is a curved peg that's used to hang clothing on.
rack	A <b>rack</b> is used for displaying objects on.
door	A <b>door</b> is a swinging or sliding barrier that will close the entrance to a room, building, or vehicle.
doorknob	A <b>doorknob</b> is a knob used to release the catch when opening a door.
lock	A <b>lock</b> is a fastener fitted to a door or drawer to keep it firmly closed.
drawer	A <b>drawer</b> is a sliding boxlike container in a piece of furniture.
entrance	An entrance provides access to another space.
front	The <b>front</b> of a house is the side that is seen first.
fuse	A <b>fuse</b> is an electrical device that can interrupt the flow of electrical current when it is overloaded.
handrail	A <b>handrail</b> is a railing at the side of a staircase or balcony to prevent people from falling.
mirror	A <b>mirror</b> is polished surface that forms images by reflecting light.
cabinet	A <b>cabinet</b> is a piece of furniture resembling a cupboard with doors and shelves and drawers.
