Spelling list: -ore - longer words

If the sound /or/ is on the end of a word it is usually spelled -ore .

adore I adore your new dress.

before Clean your shoes **before** you pack them.

deplore I deplore your bad manners.

explore Let's **explore** that old building.

galore There were apples **galore** on the tree.

ignore Kevin chose to **ignore** the warning.

implore We **implore** you to stop that awful noise.

restore We want to buy and **restore** an old house.

therefore Tom is a minor and **therefore** too young to vote.

carnivore A **carnivore** eats only meat.

herbivore A **herbivore** eats only plants.

omnivore Omnivores are animals that eat both plants and animals.
