To spell the sound /ou/ before the endings el and er use ow. At the end of a word, or the end of a syllable, use ow.

cower I cower in terror.

flower There's a **flower** seller at the station.

power It won't work if you don't switch on the **power**.

shower I have a **shower** after football training.

tower The **tower** was a unique construction.

towel The baby was wrapped in a **towel** .

trowel We use a **trowel** to put the cement on the bricks.

vowel This course teaches you about vowels.

allow The council won't **allow** any more houses here.

endow A rich business man will **endow** our new town library.

eyebrow She can raise one **eyebrow** at a time.

coward He was considered to be a **coward** by his comrades.

powder How much curry **powder** shall I use?

rowdy His **rowdy** drunken shouting made us very angry.
