

## Spelling list: Words ending in -ce

The /s/ sound on the end of a word is sometimes spelled ce . Here are some examples.

lace	The handkerchief was made from <b>lace</b> .
pace	Zac walks at a fast <b>pace</b> .
race	Sophie was breathless after the <b>race</b> .
grace	The dancer moved with <b>grace</b> .
space	A <b>space</b> probe was launched yesterday.
nice	We had a <b>nice</b> vacation.
rice	I prefer pasta to <b>rice</b> .
slice	Would you like a <b>slice</b> of cake?
spice	What <b>spice</b> should I add to the curry?
price	The <b>price</b> includes food and drink.
twice	It is important to brush your teeth <b>twice</b> a day.
voice	His <b>voice</b> was very faint.
choice	There's a <b>choice</b> of four desserts.
juice	This flask holds one litre of <b>juice</b> .
advice	The teacher gave me good <b>advice</b> .
device	The campsite has a rainwater-collecting <b>device</b> .
entice	The gym offered a cheap membership plan to <b>entice</b> new joiners.
sacrifice	Although he had to <b>sacrifice</b> some of his independence, he enjoyed being part of the team.
