practice calculator to work out the final sum.

service Call room **service** to order breakfast.

solstice The summer **solstice** is the longest day of the year.

accomplice The criminal and his **accomplice** were jailed.

apprentice The plumbing company employed Jim as an **apprentice** .

precipice She felt like she was standing at the edge of a **precipice**.

prejudice The article exposes the company's deep-rooted **prejudice** against women.
