brought The lost child was **brought** back home.

thought I **thought** you'd be ready by now.

caught The thief was **caught** in the act.

fraught There was a **fraught** silence.

distraught She was **distraught** at the thought of her kitten lost in the cold.

naughty The **naughty** child needed supervision.

haughty His manner was **haughty** and rude.

daughter My brother's **daughter** is my niece.

slaughter The lambs were taken to **slaughter**.
