

## Spelling list: Words ending in *ary*

In these words the weak vowel sound before *y* is spelled with the letters *ar* , making the ending *ary* .

anniversary	Today is the tenth <b>anniversary</b> of our marriage.

centenary	The football club celebrated its second <b>centenary</b> .
commentary	We were interested in the director's <b>commentary</b> on the film.

extraordinary	After our adventure, we told our friends about the <b>extraordinary</b> events.
hereditary	The father is worried that his illness may be <b>hereditary</b> .
imaginary	The child had an <b>imaginary</b> friend.
library	The author came to a book signing at our local <b>library</b> .
necessary	It is <b>necessary</b> to demarcate a sentence with a full stop and capital letter.
primary	I will always remember my <b>primary</b> school teachers.
ordinary	The food tasted very <b>ordinary</b> .
salary	You will get a basic <b>salary</b> plus commission.
secondary	I moved to <b>secondary</b> school at age eleven.
secretary	The <b>secretary</b> took notes during the meeting.
summary	The teacher asked them to write a <b>summary</b> of the book.
temporary	The children got <b>temporary</b> tattoos at the fair.
voluntary	My charity is a <b>voluntary</b> association.
