

## Spelling list: Long /oo/ spelled oo

The most common way of spelling the long /oo/ sound is to use the letters oo . This list has some more examples.

loose	The wire on the plug is <b>loose</b> .
moose	A <b>moose</b> is a large brown deer.
noose	The <b>noose</b> tightened.
goose	The magic <b>goose</b> laid golden eggs.
doodle	The artist was bored so she drew a quick <b>doodle</b> .
poodle	Her first dog was a <b>poodle</b> .
baboon	In the zoo, they went to see the <b>baboon</b> first.
raccoon	The camp was ambushed by a wild <b>raccoon</b> .
balloon	The family took a ride in a hot-air <b>balloon</b> .
cartoon	When they got home from school the kids watched a <b>cartoon</b> .
lagoon	We swam in the warm water of the <b>lagoon</b> .
monsoon	There may be floods in the <b>monsoon</b> season.
bamboo	The panda loves to eat <b>bamboo</b> .
kangaroo	Did you see a <b>kangaroo</b> during your visit to Australia?
shampoo	What <b>shampoo</b> do you use?
tattoo	He disliked his new <b>tattoo</b> .
