

Spelling list: *-ence* words - set 2

In these words the weak vowel sound in the final syllable is spelled with the letter *e* . These are just a few of the many words ending in *-ence* .

audience	The audience ignored the speaker.
circumference	The circumference of the circle was large.
conference	We attended the conference in Chicago.
conscience	My conscience is completely clear.
essence	Endeavour is the essence of success.
experience	The cooks traveled the world to experience authentic native cuisines.
innocence	The man appealed at court to prove his innocence .
intelligence	The intelligence team decoded the cipher easily.
interference	He focused on his work without the interference of television.
persistence	Through the persistence of his efforts he achieved his goal.
reference	If you are stuck, use the instruction book for reference .
residence	He took up residence in New York.
science	Rocket science enabled space travel.
sentence	This is the tenth sentence of this test.
sequence	A byte is a sequence of 8 bits. (Computer data terminology).
silence	Some monks make a vow of silence .
succulence	Each bite of fruit was full of succulence .
turbulence	The aeroplane experienced some turbulence .
