

Spelling list: Long /oo/ spelled ew

The letters *ew* are sometimes used to spell the long /oo/ sound. This is usually on the end of a word.

blew	The wind blew gently over the beach.
brew	The lady allowed the tea to brew .
chew	Is it rude to chew gum in church?
crew	The ship's crew took to the lifeboats.
flew	Lindbergh flew across the Atlantic in 1927.
grew	The teenager grew a lot in just a year.
shrew	In the garden, we found a shrew .
threw	She threw the ball through my window.
cashew	A popular type of nut is the cashew nut.
jewel	The ring was encrusted with a jewel .
jewellery	The king wore a lot of jewellery .
Andrew	My father is called Andrew .
