

## Spelling list: Change y to i

When you add a suffix to a word ending in a consonant + y, change the y to i , unless the suffix starts with i .  
To add s , change the y to i then add es

dry	I <b>dry</b> my hair with a towel.
dried	A <b>dried</b> plum is called a prune.
happy	The child was very <b>happy</b> .
happiest	It was the <b>happiest</b> day of my life.
reply	I need a <b>reply</b> by the weekend.
replied	Have you <b>replied</b> to that email?
fly	I love to <b>fly</b> my kite.
flies	He <b>flies</b> in the aeroplane to Spain.
nasty	A bully is a <b>nasty</b> person.
nastiness	The <b>nastiness</b> of some players spoiled the game.
pony	Did you have a ride on the black <b>pony</b> ?
ponies	Rosie loves to ride <b>ponies</b> .
study	You will need to <b>study</b> hard to become a doctor.
studies	A zoologist <b>studies</b> animals.
beauty	She loved watching <b>beauty</b> tutorials online.
beautiful	There's a <b>beautiful</b> view from my balcony.
