Sampson	<b>Sampson</b> is a servant to Capulet.
Gregory	<b>Gregory</b> is a servant to Capulet.
Peter	<b>Peter</b> is a servant to Juliet's nurse.
Abraham	<b>Abraham</b> is a servant to Montague.
Juliet	<b>Juliet</b> is a daughter to Capulet.
