

## Spelling list: Words ending in age

The /ij/ sound on the end of a word is usually spelled age - but take care: this list contains two rule-breakers !

baggage	How much <b>baggage</b> do you plan to take with you?
bandage	The nurse wrapped a <b>bandage</b> around his wound.
cottage	The <b>cottage</b> had a beautiful garden.
courage	I admire her <b>courage</b> .
damage	Was the <b>damage</b> caused by a tornado?
garbage	What day is the <b>garbage</b> collected?
image	The <b>image</b> showed a detailed cross section of the human brain.
manage	Do you think you'll <b>manage</b> to finish your work in time for the party?
message	She came with an urgent <b>message</b> .
package	The policeman investigated the suspicious <b>package</b> .
passage	They walked down the <b>passage</b> .
postage	How much is the <b>postage</b> on this card?
sausage	The <b>sausage</b> sizzled in the pan.
shortage	After the earthquake there was a <b>shortage</b> of fresh water.
storage	My new computer has much more <b>storage</b> space.
village	The doctor's practice was on the edge of the <b>village</b> .
advantage	The home team had the <b>advantage</b> .
average	The teacher calculated the <b>average</b> test score for the class.
knowledge	Bill has an extensive <b>knowledge</b> of history.
