

Spelling list: Final consonant blends - set 3

This list focuses on final consonant blends in words that are practical and relevant to daily life. A final consonant blend is when two or more consonants are merged together at the end of a word, like *lt* in *melt* . These blends are key to developing strong spelling foundations. By practising these words, learners will improve their phonetic recognition and spelling abilities.

list Her mother gave her a shopping **list** .

belt His **belt** was too tight.

melt The chocolate will **melt** in the sun.

camp We made **camp** in the woods.

vest He wore a grey **vest** .

bunk We slept on **bunk** beds on holiday.

wink I **wink** to show I'm joking.

kilt The groom wore a **kilt** to his wedding.
