

Spelling list: Initial and final consonant blends - set 3

Test yourself on these spellings with consonant blends at both the beginning and the end! A consonant blend occurs when two consonants come together to make a new sound, like *bl-* and *-nk* in *blink* . How many can you spell correctly?

blink	The bright light made me blink .
frost	The frost glistened on the spider's web.
twist	You need to twist the lid.
frank	She tried to be frank when giving her opinion.
grand	The house was extremely grand .
swept	An icy draught swept through the street.
scrap	We used scrap paper to make art.
strip	The light in the garage is a fluorescent strip .
