| Uchendu | Uchendu is the younger brother of Okonkwo's mother. |
| Commissioner | The District Commissioner is an authority figure in the white colonial government in Nigeria. |
| Unoka | Unoka is Okonkwo's father. |
| Obierika | Obierika is Okonkwo's close friend. |
| Ekwefi | Ekwefi is Okonkwo's second wife who was once the village beauty. |
